A YES vote on April 3rd will:

- Widen Lyle Road to 4 lanes to include curbs
 - Construct a sidewalk along Lyle Road
- Provide drainage improvements along Lyle Road

If this proposition is approved by voters, a 1/2 cent sales tax will be implemented specifically for the Lyle Road improvements. The 1/2 cent sales tax will last for 6 years. Any proceeds left over after Lyle Road improvements are completed, will be used for other road and drainage improvements in the City of Weatherford.



We cannot rely on the State or Federal Government to provide all of the funds for needed municipal infrastructure improvements.

Sales tax is a fair way to finance this type of project. Visitors to Weatherford (many use Lyle Road to get to Rader Park or the Stafford Air & Space Museum) who make sales tax eligible purchases will help with this project. The total cost of the reconstruction does not fall solely on the citizens of Weatherford.
